

**MCGREGOR CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
OCTOBER 13, 2022 4:45 P.M.**

The MCGREGOR CITY COUNCIL met in Special Session at 4:45 p.m. on **Thursday, October 13, 2022** at City Hall with Mayor Lyle Troester presiding. The meeting was called to order at 4:45p.m. Council members attending: Wild, Schneider, Hallberg, Echard and Carroll.

Council reviewed a recommendation from the personnel committee to fill the Public Works Director – Wastewater Operator position that is currently held by Ren Pape. The position was posted as required. Wild moved, seconded by Schneider to make an offer of employment to Jason Wagner effective beginning October 17, 2022 for \$25.92 per hour with all full time benefits and stipend of \$20 per month for cell phone in lieu of moving his phone to city plan. Roll call vote: Ayes – all. Motion carried.

Revisions to the Wastewater – street Maintenance job description were discussed. The position will be revised to Street Maintenance – Public Works Assistant. More emphasis is placed on streets, parks and facility maintenance with some wastewater knowledge but without the requirement to obtain a license for wastewater. The employee may, however, work towards a license if interested. Hallberg moved, seconded by Schneider to approve the revised job description as presented. Hallberg moved, seconded by Echard to post/publish the open position for Street Maintenance/Public Works Assistant. Roll call vote: Ayes – all. Motion carried.

Quotes from two sources were provided for a replacement vehicle for snow plowing. Kayser Commercial Sales in Madison has a truck on the lot scheduled to be equipped with the Snow Fighter Package within the next few weeks. Echard moved, seconded by Hallberg to approve the quote from Kayser Commercial Sales in the amount of \$121,000 with a deduction of \$22,000 for trade in of the city's F550. Roll call vote: Ayes – all. Motion carried.

McManus asked that the council provide recommendations for the wall at 116 7th St. for the regular council meeting on October 19.

With business concluded, Hallberg moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Wild. Ayes – All. Meeting adjourned.
